

Perpignan (pɛʁpinɑ̃) is the southernmost city of France and capital of the Pyrénées-Orientales county. With almost 120.000 inhabitants, Perpignan is the largest city after Montpellier and Toulouse in the Occitanie Region.

Centuries ago, Perpignan was part of the **Catalan region**. In the 13<sup>th</sup> and the 14<sup>th</sup> century it was the continental capital of the Kingdom of Majorca. Today you can still visit the Palais des Rois de Majorque, the former castle and military base of Perpignan.

All over the year, Perpignan is visited by 4 million tourists. Being so close to the **Mediterrane- an Sea and the Pyrenees**, it attracts all sorts of people. The beautiful coastline and villages like **Collioure** are why so many people love the south of France. And being only **1.5 hours away from the nearest ski stations** is also very attractive.

Of course there's a lot more to see in the region from natural beaches to medieval cities, cultural sites and wine valleys. Big cities like **Montpellier and Toulouse** are easily accessible by train and definitely worth a visit. Even going across the border to **Barcelona or Figueras** is easy by train or bus.




